Lead Story Inauguration of Incubation Facility at STPI-Srinagar

Shri Ravi Shankar Prasad, Hon'ble Union Minister of Electronics & Information Technology, Communications and Law & Justice inaugurated "STPI-Srinagar incubation facility" on 22nd January, 2020 at Srinagar in the gracious presence of Dr. Ohkar Rai, Director Generatiol STPI. The additional facility of about 24,000 sq. It. constructed at STPI, SIDOC Electronics: Camplex Rangrath, Srinagar will meet the growing demand of IT/ITeS MSMEs of the region. Currently, J&K has three STP units, employing around 140 resources are registered with STPI. For FY 2019-20, estimated exports from these units are expected to be around flas. 676 Cr.

On this occasion, Hordble minister Shri Ravi Shankar Prasad stated, "The incubation facility at STPI-Srinagar will provide opportunities to IT antrepreneurs by providing plug-n-play and other digital infrastructure along with regulatory support to develop and export IT products from the Union Territory of Jammu & Kashmir."

Coronavirus Impact:

Software Technology Parks Empowered IT/ITeS Firms to Work from Home

In a procautionary move to check spread of deadly coronavirus, Software Technology Parks of India on 13th March 2020 Issued advisory that enabled around 18-20 lakh employees of IT/ITeS companies registered with it to work from home.

"There are rules that allow amployees to work from home in cartain situation. We have issued those enabling clauses and will motivate all units registered with us to implement it. There are around 3,000 exporters registered with us and around 18-20 lakh employees work with them," said DL: Omkar Rai, Director General, STPI.

The urgent advisory issued by STPI, which overseas facilities and rules for software exporters, said in the wake of the coronavirus outbreak, units may require employees to work from home using the laptop or desktop provided by the unit to them. "In this connection, para-6.07 of HBDP (handbook of procedures) of FTP, inter-alia, permits employees of STP/EHTP units to take duty-free laptops/computers, etc, out of premises of units for working upon by authorised amployees," the advisory said.

Business continuity and employee safety remains key priority during Covid-19. IT industry is putting contingency measures and leveraging tochnology to ensure business continuity for its customers and employces. Companies have been extensively deploying technology solutions and online collaboration tools for business interactions, client meetings and internal workouts, allowing employees to work from home wherever possible.

Year 2020 will see social interactive gaming and eSports become mainstream. India ranks fifth among the world's top mobile gaming
