## Message from **Director General**

ndia is at the cusp of digital revolution. While advanced technologies such as AI, IoT and Blockchain are making Indian IT behemoths ambitious and tread aggressively, the government is equally concerned to put the tier-2/3 cities on the map of IT revolution in India. The Indian metros have attracted big domestic and international IT players by leveraging the proactive government IT policy, huge engineering talent pool and IT grade infrastructure. The success is evident from the growth of IT industry since 1991 when the industry turnover was just USD 1 billion and after two and half decades it's USD 167 billion (estimated) in 2018 for IT-BPM industry.

Once BPO centres are set up in small towns and cities and start operations, they not only create direct employment for local youth but also they generate further opportunities for ancillary sectors to operate and create indirect employment. Eventually the BPO centres are creating a holistic ecosystem for economic growth of the locality, which is the core objective of the India BPO Promotion Scheme. Moreover, the strong foundation laid by the Indian IT industry is also being leveraged for the all-inclusive growth of smaller/muffasil towns through this scheme. With employment and economic dividend to regional players, these programmes have been significantly

While the country has noticed the glaring success of IT industry during the last three decades particularly in metros, the tier-2/3 cities were not able to capitalize such opportunities due to numerous reasons. As a result educated youth from smaller towns migrated to metros in search of jobs. The migration put more pressure on the civic amenities and infrastructure of the tier-1 cities and it was also not cost-effective for the youth of tier-2/3 cities. Even the migrated youth got jobs in metros, they were not able to cater to the family needs in a holistic manner.

In order to resolve the underlined issues and challenges of youth of tier-2/3 cities, the Government of India envisaged India BPO Promotion Scheme with a vision to generate employment and attract investment to smaller towns. This scheme envisioned for creating 48,300 seats has the potential to create 1.5 lakh direct employment opportunities for local youth of tier-2/3 cities. The programme is being implemented by STPI across the country. As in the past STPI has played a vital role in making India the IT destination of the world successfully, it's now leveraging that experience to drive this programme to meet the larger objectives of this scheme. reducing the rural-urban divide, alleviating the load of migration to metros and paving the way for a resurgent India that echoes the inclusive development for all citizens.

After two years of launch, India BPO Promotion Scheme (IBPS) is thriving successfully. Employment opportunities for local youth have been created by various companies in small towns across the country. Moreover, through this scheme a significant number of women have been employed promoting the women empowerment in small towns. Currently, these BPO units are providing services in 16 languages including Arabic and Spanish in various verticals including, but not limited to healthcare, KPO, e-Commerce, e-Learning, technical support, medical transcription and digital marketing to the international clients from USA, UK, and Canada. Given the progress of this scheme, the government's vision for creating employment opportunities for youth in or near their hometown is getting realized. □
